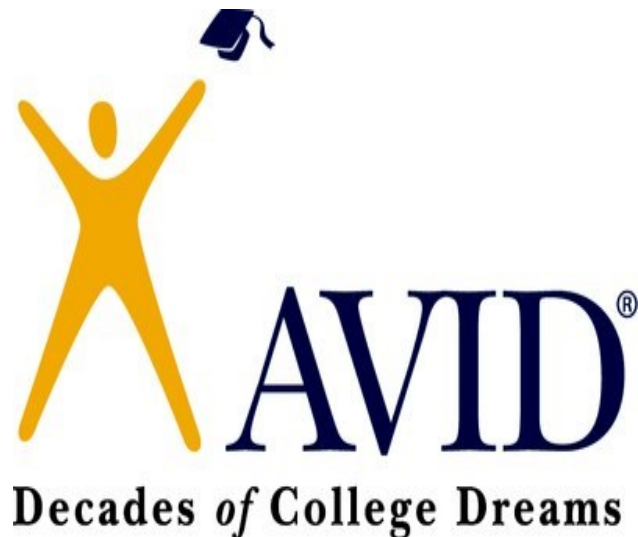

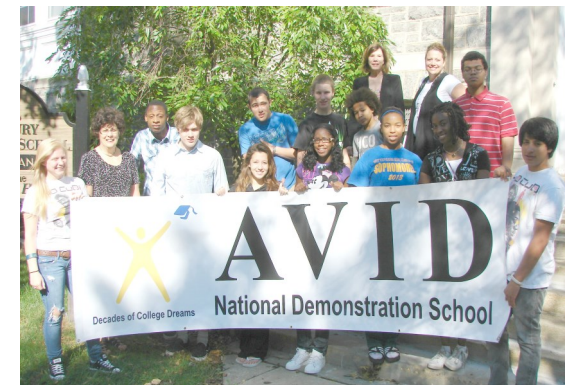

What is AVID?

Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) is a middle through post-secondary college readiness system that is designed to increase school-wide learning and student performance. AVID focuses on the least served students in the “academic middle,” students who are motivated and exhibit good citizenship but may not have benefited from gifted and talented programs.

AVID students are enrolled in an AVID Elective Class which meets every day. In this class, they work to improve their note-taking, organization, study-skills and collaborative technique. An AVID student is additionally enrolled in at least one Honors or Advanced Placement Class. AVID students are required to apply to one four-year college and are required to take the SAT during high school. They are expected to maintain a minimum of a “C” average in their core content academic areas.

How can I become a Woodbury AVID student?

1. Notice of Intent to Participate in School Choice Program by parent or guardian must be given to the District of Residence's Superintendent by 12/1/2014.
2. Student application must be completed by the student, parent/guardian application must be completed by the parent/guardian and sent along with the eligibility confirmation from the district of residence to the Choice District by the parent/guardian by 12/1/2014.
3. Parent/guardian will receive notification of the student’s eligibility and if needed, a lottery will be held between 12/12/2014 and 12/19/2014.
4. Choice District will notify parent of conditional acceptance, rejection or wait-listing by 12/20/2014.
5. Parent must give the notice of intent to register to the Choice District by 1/6/2015.

[NOTE: Procedures differ for non-public school students.]
