On Monday, May 5th, your child will begin taking a four-day state-wide standardized test called the New Jersey Assessment of Skills and Knowledge (NJASK-5).


This test will assess acquired skills in Language Arts Literacy and Mathematics. It is our belief that we have prepared all of our students with the skills to perform well on this assessment.

In order to maximize our students' ability to achieve success, here are some helpful hints to ensure students come to school relaxed, well rested and ready for test day:

- Encourage students to get plenty of sleep the night before each test.
- Provide each student with a nourishing breakfast the morning of the test or send them to our complimentary breakfast program May 5th – May 8th from 8:20-8:30.
- Try to ensure all students arrive to school on time and are present the entire week.
