Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Gloucester County Health Department will be holding an H1N1 Flu clinic at the Woodbury Junior-Senior High School on Saturday, November 21, 2009, for students ages 4 through 9. The clinic will run from 9:00 AM-11:00 AM and take place in the Junior/Senior High School cafeteria. **The clinic is only available to school-aged students who reside in Woodbury.**

The Health Department has notified us that only the "shot form" of the vaccine will be available. A parent/guardian must accompany any elementary school child (grades Pre-K-5) and be present throughout the vaccination process. The shot is only available to children 4 years of age and older.

To facilitate the process, we are asking that children whose last names begin with the letters A-L report from 9:00-9:30 and children with last names beginning with M-Z report from 10:00-10:30. Please complete the attached pre-registration form and return it to the main office of your child's school no later than Thursday, November 19<sup>th</sup>. **Children who do not pre-register will receive the vaccination based upon availability from 10:30-11:00.**
