Greetings from Woodbury Junior—Senior High School!

School doors open for our students on Thursday,

September 6, 2007. All students will report to school on a staggered schedule:

Junior High students – Grades 6th, 7th, and 8th – will report to school prepared to enter the auditorium lobby doors (on the other side of the sixth grade annex) at **7:50 a.m.** and report to the auditorium. Mr. Jason Vivadelli, our Junior High School Assistant Principal will use that opportunity to welcome each student personally to a brand new school year!

Senior High School students—Grades 9 – 12- will report at **8:30 a.m.**, directly to the auditorium through the Lobby entrance. **Mr. Steven Morris**, our Senior High School Assistant Principal will greet and welcome each Senior High student to start off an exciting year.

The meetings for both schools will last about 15 – 20 minutes at which point each class will be dismissed to their assigned homerooms.

Lunch will be served on the first day of school. You may purchase a lunch (\$2.00 for regular and 40 cents for reduced). A la carte items and snacks may also be purchased. Students who received reduced or free lunch last year will be issued a temporary lunch card. The enclosed lunch application must be completed and processed for the new school year. Please remember to return the application on the first day of school — **Thursday, September 6!**

Physical examinations are required for all students who want to participate in any sport.

All students who plan to participate in a fall sport must submit all forms, including the medical, no later than **September 10**. No student will be permitted to participate in practice, scrimmages, and/or games until the appropriate forms have been approved by the school.
