3rd Mid- Marking Period Updates

Greetings Parents and Guardians,

Marking period dates have been modified because of the school closings we experienced this winter. The new date for the end of the third (3rd) marking period is **April 16**.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE: Your support has been great; thank you! As we close out the 2008-2009 school year, please remember that your child must be in attendance 166 days in order to receive credit for the year or be promoted to the next grade. Your child's attendance status is noted on every mid- marking and end of marking period report; personal letters are sent each month to parents of students who are truant or in danger of satisfying the policy each month.
