ATTENDANCE POLICY REMINDER

Please help us help your
children to be mindful of the
attendance policy.

Students must be **present for
one-hundred sixty-six (166)
days in order to be awarded
course credit regardless of the
reason for the absence.**

A student may attend a credit
completion session (Saturday
Attendance School Program) to
regain denied credit, provided
the student **has been in
attendance for one-hundred
forty-five (145) days.**

For courses meeting for less
than a full year, a student
needs to be in attendance
ninety percent (90%) of the
days.”
