

WALNUT STREET SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL

Responsibilities

Hours: 8:15--8:30 a.m. (Breakfast safety helpers only.)
8:25--8:35a.m. (Crossers and Doors)
12:00--12:20 p.m. (Teacher helpers)
2:55--3:05 p.m. (Crossers and Doors)

1. The primary responsibilities of safety patrol members are to help younger students cross the street safely, to see that school rules are obeyed, to set an example of good behavior for other students and to help teachers as needed.
2. Safety Responsibilities:
 - A. Be on duty on time!
 - B. Wear your safety belt properly for crossings.
 - C. Behave in an orderly manner while on duty – no horseplay or fooling around!
 - D. Serious or repeated misbehavior or rule breaking should be reported to the Officers. Officers will report issues to Mrs. Pierce. Warnings can be issued by Mrs. Pierce for not following these rules. Three warnings = 1 week suspension from post. Three more warnings = loss of safety privileges for the rest of the year.
3. Academic learning is a priority. If a student is not able to keep up with work, the decision to be a safety will be reconsidered.
4. Cold weather: Safeties do not go on post when the wind chill is below 25 degrees. Listen to KYW 1060 AM in the morning for an accurate temperature report. If it is very cold or windy outside, dress warmly.
5. The first safety belt and badge will be provided free of charge. The following fees apply to lost belts and badges:
 - A. lost belt: \$5.00
 - B. lost badge: \$1.00
