

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The behavior modification system that we use in our classroom is a "Stay Green" chart. The children begin each day with a green card showing. If they make good behavior decisions all day, they will stay green and get a sticker on their sticker chart. When a poor behavior decision is made, the child will have to change their card to yellow. A yellow card means that the student will miss 5 minutes of centers and the child will not receive a sticker. Continued poor behavior will cause a card change to orange. An orange card means that the child misses the entire center time and again, no sticker. Lastly there is a red card. A red card means that negative behaviors continued all day or that the student became physical with another child. In this situation, the student meets with Dr. Adams, our principal. This month I am going to begin sending home a calendar that will show you which color your child's card was each day. Please review the calendar each day and return it to the back pocket of your child's school folder. At the end of each week, please sign the chart and return it on Monday. If your child does not stay green, I will comment as to the action that caused the color change. If you would like to make comments, please do so on the side of the paper. You may also attach a separate note.
