Students are to read or be read to for a total of 6 hours (360 minutes). This will entitle them to a free admission ticket to a Six Flags Park, including Great Adventure. We start **Monday, January 14th** and end on **Thursday, February 14th**. If your child reads or is read to a minimum of 12 minutes each day (30 days), he/she will have 360 minutes/6 hours by the deadline.
