Halloween Parade Route

The Halloween Parade will be held in the front of the school on the Queen Street side. Students will exit through the main entrance and walk down the new side walk along the building. From the sidewalk, they will turn left on Queen Street heading toward the primary doors.

Once students reach the crosswalk by the primary wing, they will turn and go back down Queen heading toward Jackson. The students will cross at the crosswalk along the intersection of Queen and Jackson and proceed back to the building. Once they reach the front entrance, they will return inside the building through the main entrance.

Parents may view the parade on both sides of Queen Street. The parade will begin promptly at 2:15.

Upon the conclusion of the parade, students, teachers and room parents (two per class) will enter the classroom to have a small snack. For security reasons, only two parents from each class may enter the building.
